RESPONSIBILITY

1 Corinthians 13:11

Responsibility: Something that it is your job or duty to deal with. The state or fact of being responsible.

Being responsible is part of growing up . It is something that each and everyone of us must face at some point in our lives . No matter where we may run and hide , we will still have to face responsibility whether at home or away . Some will try to escape responsibility by placing it on someone else . Not realizing that the one you gave your problem to , that they have there on problem to take care of . So why pass your responsibility on to someone else .

1.1 Corinthians 13:11

- A . When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.
- B. When I was a child, I talked like a child; I thought like a child; I made plans like a child. When I became a man, I stopped those childish ways.
- 2. Galatians 6:5
- A . For every man shall bear his own burden.
- B. Each person must accept his own responsibility.
- 3 . Luke 12:47-48
- A . And that servant, which knew his lord's will, and prepared not *himself*, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with **many** *stripes*. But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, **shall be beaten** with **few** *stripes*. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- B. That servant knew what his master wanted him to do. But that servant did not make himself ready or try to do what his master wanted. So that servant will be punished very much! But what about the servant that does not know what his master wants? The servant does things that deserves punishment. But he will get less punishment than the servant that knew what he should do. Any person that has been given much will be responsible for much. Much more will be expected from the person that has been given more.

The more we know the more is expected

- 4. Proverbs 22:6
- A . Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.
- B. Teach a child the right way to live while he is young. Then when he grows older, he will continue living that way.
- 5 . Ezekiel 18:20
- A . The soul that sinneth, it shall die. <u>The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father</u>, <u>neither shall the father</u> <u>bear the iniquity of the son</u>: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him.
- B. The person that sins is the person that will be put to death! A son won't be punished for his father's sins. And a father won't be punished for his son's sins. A good man's goodness belongs to him alone. And a bad man's evil belongs to him alone.
- 6. Matthew 12:37
- A . For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.
- B . The words you have said will be used to judge you . Some of your words will make you right , but some of your words will make you guilty .
- 7. Luke 16:10
- A . He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much.
- B . If a person can be trusted with small things , then he can be trusted with big things . If a person is dishonest in little things , then he will be dishonest in big things too .

Still talking about responsibility

- 8. Genesis 3:12 -13 Back to the Beginning (Adam & Eve) Tried to pass on Responsibility
- A . And the <u>man said</u>, The <u>woman</u> whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat .And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the <u>woman said</u>, The <u>serpent</u> beguiled me, and I did eat.
- B . The <u>man said</u>, the **woman** you made for me gave me fruit from that tree . So I ate it . Then the Lord God said to the woman, what have **you** done? The woman said, the snake tricked me. He fooled me and I ate the fruit.

9. Joshua 7:15 Achan was held responsible for his sins at Jericho

A . And it shall be, that he that is taken with the accursed thing shall be burnt with fire, he and all that he hath:

because he hath transgressed the covenant of the LORD, and because he hath wrought folly in Israel.

B. The man who is keeping those things that we should have destroyed will be caught. Then that man will be destroyed by fire. And everything that he owns will be destroyed with him. That man broke the agreement

with the Lord . He has done a very bad thing to the people of Israel .

10.2 Corinthians 5:10

A . For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his

body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

B . We must all stand before Christ to be judged . Each person will get what he should . Each person will be paid

for the things he did – good or bad – when he lived in the earthly body.

Hope today that we can understand, that we can't escape our responsibility. We will be held accountable.

Each and everyone of us have a job to do , and it is our duty to follow through with it . Whatsoever it may be .
