A TIME TO TALK

Ecclesiastes 3:7

Talking : Spoken words .

Do we understand that the bible say that there is a time and a place for everything. To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heavens. When its time to sing praises the the Lord, We all should be singing praises. When its time to talk, we should be talking. When its time to be silent we should use that time for that purpose. If we are using this time out of order and not at the right time, it will cause problems for the people around us. No matter where we may be.

1. Ecclesiastes 3:7

A . A time to rend, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak .

B. There is a time to tear cloth , and there is a time to sew it . There is a time to be silent , and a time to speak .

2 . Proverbs 17:28

A . Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise: *and* he that shutteth his lips *is esteemed* a man of understanding.

B. Even a fool seems wise if he keeps quiet . People think he is wise if he doesn't say anything .

- 3. Luke 10:39 Mary was even listening to Jesus
- A . And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.
- B . Martha had a sister named Mary . Mary was sitting at Jesus feet and listening to him teach .
- 4 . Ephesians 4:29

A . Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

B. When you talk , don't say any bad things . But say things that people need – things that will help other people become stronger . Then the things you say will help the people who listen to you .

See , the talking that we do sometimes, is not meant for everybody but everybody can hear it. And be disturbed by it or distracted .

5 . James 1:26

A . If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion *is* vain.

B . you may think you are religious (good) . But if you say things you should not say , then you are fooling yourself . Your religion is worth nothing .

* Talkative people often do not take the time between their many words to choose their words carefully .

6. Psalms 141:3

A . Set a watch , o Lord , before my mouth ; keep the door of my lips

B. Lord , help me control the things I say . Help me watch what I say .

7. Luke 12:3 Jesus is speaking to his followers

A . Therefore whatsoever ye have spoken in **darkness** shall be **heard in the light**; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in **closets** shall be proclaimed upon the **housetops**.

B. The things you say in the dark (secretly) will be told in the light (openly). The things you whisper in a private room will be shouted from the top of the house.

8. Proverbs 18:21

A . Death and life *are* in the power of the **tongue**: and they that **love it** <u>shall eat the fruit thereof</u>.

B . The tongue can speak words that bring life or death . And people who love to talk must be ready to accept what it brings .

9.2 Timothy 2:16

A . But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

B. Stay away from people who talk about useless things that are not from God . That kind of talk will lead a person more and more against God .

Remember, we can't stop anyone from talking. But what we can do, is ignore someone if it is ungodly talking which does no one any good.

There is a time and a place for everything .

We always remind everyone here to please put phone on silent . Because **we don't want it to disturb other members** . **Showing respect for others**

10 . James 1:19

A . Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath .

B. My dear brothers and sisters, always be more willing to listen than to speak. Don't become angry easily.

11 . Proverbs 21:23

- A . Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.
- B. If a person is careful about the things he says, then he saves himself from trouble.

Hope today that we can understand concerning, there is a time to talk. We don't need to be disruptive around others. We need to be respectable at all times. We are the light that sit up on the hill. People are known by the way they act. Please continue to show others respect.
