## **OVERWHELMED**

Psalms 34:17-20

Overwhelmed: To be overcome completely in mind or feelings

#### 1. Psalms 34:17-20

A. The righteous cry, and the Lord heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles. The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all. **He keepeth all his bones**: **not one of them is broken**.

B. Pray to the Lord and he will hear you. He will save you from all your troubles. When some people have troubles they stop being proud. The Lord is close to those humble people. He will save them. Good people might have many problems, but the Lord will save them from every one of their problems. The Lord will protect all their bones. **Not one bone will be broken**.

# 2. Philippians 4:19

A. But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

B. My God is very rich with the glory of Christ Jesus. God will use his riches in Christ Jesus to give you everything you need.

## 3. 2 Corinthians 12:9

A. And he said unto me, my grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

B. But the Lord said to me, my grace (kindness) is enough for you. When you are weak, then my power is made perfect in you. So I am very happy to boast about my weaknesses. Then Christ's power can live in me.

## 4. Matthew 11:28

- A. Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- B. Come to me all you people that are tired and have heavy burdens. I will give you rest.
- 5. Romans 8:1

A. There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the spirit.

B. So now people that are in Christ Jesus are not judged guilty.

- 6. Jeremiah 15:16
- A. Thy words were found , and I did eat them ; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart : for I am called by thy name , **O Lord God of host** .
- B. Your message came to me and I ate your words. Your message made me very happy. I was happy to be called by your name. Your name is **Lord All-Powerful**.
- 7. Psalms 139:1-4
- God's all seeing eye
- David's cry to the Lord
- A . O Lord, thou hast searched me, and known me. Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways. For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, o Lord, thou knowest it altogether.
- B. Lord, you tested me. You know all about me. You know when I sit down and when I get up. You know my thoughts from far away. Lord, you know where I am going and when am lying down. You know everything I do. Lord, you know what I want to say, even before the words leave my mouth.
- 8. Matthew 19:26 (rich young man) salvation is never won by human attainment (Disciples)
- A. But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, with men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.
- B. Jesus looked at his followers and said, this is something that people cannot do themselves. But God can do all things
- 9. 2 Timothy 1:7
- A. For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- B. The spirit God gave us does not make us afraid. He is our source of power and love and self control.
- 10. Psalms 119:105
- A. Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
- B. Lord, **your words** are like a lamp lighting my path.
- 11. James 5:11
- A. Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.
- B. We say that those people who accepted their troubles with patience now have God's blessing. You have heard about **job's patience**. You know that after all job's trouble, **the Lord helped him**. This shows that the **Lord is full of mercy** and is **kind**.
